

Flavio de Marco: Portrait of a Collection

4 November to 20 December 2009

On Tuesday 3 November, 6.30 to 8.30 pm, the Estorick Collection will hold the Private View of Flavio de Marco's paintings.

Contemporary Italian artist Flavio de Marco (born Lecce 1975) is best known for his works based on the landscape of the computer screen. For this project, he has created a series of paintings representing his personal journey through the Estorick Collection.

De Marco selects fragments of landscape from the works of the various artists represented in the Collection, which he then incorporates into his own distinctive works. *Portrait of a Collection* will hang alongside the permanent collection, giving visitors the opportunity to view Flavio de Marco's paintings in the context of their inspiration and providing a new insight into the Estorick's own works.
